### Okayama Korakuen Garden



Okayama Korakuen Garden, built some 300 years ago as a place of resting for domain lords, is one of Japan's three great gardens and belongs to the area's daimyo (domain lord). This garden has been awarded 3 stars by the Michelin Green Guide Japan. \*Opening hours vary according to season.

- Admission: General 400 yen, Seniors 140 yen (65 and older) ■ Access: 15 minutes by bus from JR Okayama Sta. to "Korakuen-mae" bus stop

### Okayama Castle



Towering right next to Okayama Korakuen Garden is Okayama Castle, one of Japan's top 100 castles. The costume rental facilities, offering visitors the chance to experience the castle as a feudal lord or a princess, are popular destinations. \*Opening dates and hours vary according to season.

## Bizen Osafune Japanese Sword Museum



Located in Osafune—the sword capital of Japan, known for both its quality and quantity of sword production—the Bizen Osafune Japanese Sword Museum is dedicated to exhibiting Japanese swords. With temperatures reaching 1,300 degrees Celsius and sparks flying through the air, the metal workshop demonstration is an exciting experience for visitors. \*Closed Monday and the day following a holiday (closed temporarily during exhibition exchanges).

### Kurashiki Bikan Historical Area



With the white 'Namako-kabe' walls (covered with square tiles joined with raised plaster) and latticed windows of townhouses lining the streets, the Kurashiki Bikan Historical Area offers visitors a look at the charming beauty of traditional Japanese architecture. Rather than walking, the view from the Kurashiki Funenagashi riverboat cruise offers visitors a different perspective from which to enjoy the townscape.
